## **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

- Conference with the board's attorney to discuss matters which are the subject of pending or imminent court action.
- Preparing for, conducting, or reviewing negotiations or bargaining sessions with employees.
- Matters required to be kept confidential by federal law or rules or state statutes.
- Specialized details of security arrangements.

The treasurer or a board member may indicate knowledge of a reason for executive session by stating one or more reasons above. A motion is then required to enter into executive session.
